



69. Five spots

The game is an engaging way to fill those times when children are waiting for the bell and can become restless.

What you need: blackboard, whiteboard or flip chart

What to do:

Everyone sits in their place looking at the whiteboard.

One child is chosen to come forward and put five dots anywhere on the whiteboard.

A second child is chosen to come forward and draw a person with head, hands and feet touching a different dot. Encourage them to be inventive.

If there is time, you can ask for positive comments about neatness, cleverness, humour, etc.
